After Surgery Instructions

Some swelling and a little bit of bleeding is expected within *the next two days*.

Keep the ice pack on during the **first two hours** after surgery. An ice pack placed over your cheek where the implant or graft was done may reduce swelling. As soon as possible, put the ice pack over the area for 20 minutes, then remove for 20 minutes, and repeat. Continue for the first two hours post-operatively to help reduce the amount of swelling.

Take **pain medication** as prescribed. Be aware that this medication can make you drowsy. You should not drive or operate machinery while you are taking it. If you choose not to have precription pain medication, *Ibuprofen is not to exceed 3,200mg in a 24 hour period* and *Tylenol is not to exceed 3,900mg in a 24 hour period*. If prescribed, continue your **antibiotics** until gone, do not stop taking them.

During the next week:

Do not smoke
Do not eat or drink hot food or liquid
Do not suck through a straw
Do not chew on hard food
Do not brush or floss around the surgical site
Do not pull on lips or cheeks; this may disturb the healing of the surgical site
If you receive a surgical stent or immediate denture, please do not remove it until the next moring.

Bruising marks may appear on the skin of the face and neck during the first few days after surgery. Occasionally a swelling or bruising may last longer than a week. Usually the worst swelling is on the third day after the surgery and gets better with every consecutive day. **Call us immediately if the numbness continues longer than several hours** after the surgery. A **soft diet** is recommended for the next week. Some examples are: eggs, yogurt, cooked cereal, soft pasta, baked fish, canned fruits and vegetables, mashed potatoes, soups, ice cream or pudding. Ensure or Boost nutritional supplements may also be helpful.

If given a **PerioRx**, you should start rinsing with **PerioRx** today. Fill measuring cup to the fill line (1/2 ounce). Swish in mouth undiluted for 30 seconds and expel remainder. **Do not eat of drink for 30 minutes** following use. Use after breakfast, after lunch and before bedtime. Continue using **PerioRx** for <u>one week only</u>.
